



Student & Parent Agreement Form

All 6th, 7th, and 8th grade students at Friends Christian Middle School, along with their parents, must read and sign this agreement and submit it to the school prior to beginning classes.

1. Each student is fully responsible for his or her Chromebook and it is the responsibility of each student to ensure the security of his or her device. FCS shall not be liable for loss, damage, misuse, or theft of any personally owned Chromebook brought to school. Personal devices cannot be left at school before or after school hours.
2. Students are responsible for the proper care of their Chromebooks, including any costs of repair, replacement or any modifications needed to use the device at school.
3. Chromebooks must be fully charged prior to bringing them to school and must be capable of running off their own battery while at school.
4. Students should have a working knowledge of their Chromebook prior to bringing it into the learning environment.
5. The school reserves the right to temporarily confiscate a student's personal device if there is reason to believe that the student has violated the Electronic Device Policy, the Acceptable Use Policy, or any school rules.
6. Students must immediately comply with teachers' request to shut down devices or close the screen.
7. Students must use the secured wireless network provided by the school. Use of any other internet connection is prohibited.
8. Students are expected to respect and protect the privacy of others and are not permitted to capture, transmit, or post photographs/videos of any person on campus or in attendance of any event to individuals, public or social networking sites unless directed by school staff.
9. Students are not allowed to use their devices for any personal email or messaging. Devices are to be used for educational purposes only.
10. Students should not physically share their personal devices with other students.

RETURN PERMISSION FORM TO THE SCHOOL

I understand that the use of personal devices to support educational experiences is not a necessity, but a privilege. With respect to the rules, the privilege will enhance the learning environment as a whole. When rules are abused, privileges will be taken away.
